Comprehensive sexuality education is learning that begins during early childhood, and continues throughout life, concerning the physical, emotional, mental and social aspect of sexual and reproductive health and rights, inclusive of sexuality and relationships. Considered to be a lifelong process, CSE extends beyond the school curriculum and should be accessible to all individuals regardless of age and their engagement with the education system.

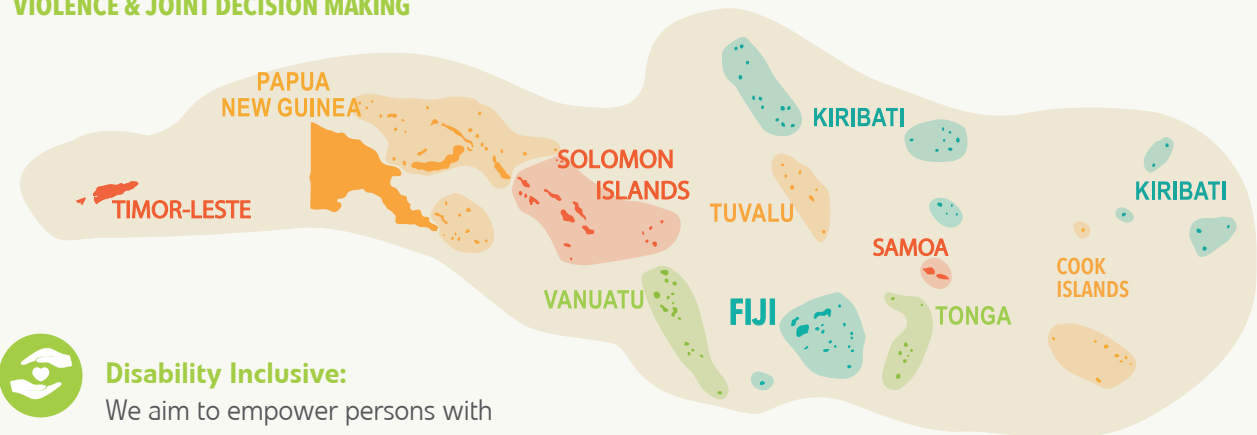

Comprehensive:

We provide evidence-based CSE programs, resources, materials and clinical services that meet the learning needs of the community, inclusive of vulnerable populations, to make informed choices regarding their own sexual and reproductive health.



Disability Inclusive:

We aim to empower persons with people with disability, as well as their teachers, parents and carers. We aim to empower people with disability to make informed decisions about their sexual health and well-being.



Gender Transformative:

We support models that have women and girls at the centre. Our packages also target men and boys as agents of change for gender equality.

OUR APPROACH



Build Partnerships:

We engage with health systems and local communities to design and deliver customised comprehensive sexuality education.



Health Promotion:

We provide health professionals and community educators with the skills to deliver appropriate comprehensive sexuality education for everyone.



Capacity Building:

We provide ongoing training and professional development for educators and community workers to build local capacity and ensure programs are locally owned and sustained.



Evidence-based:

We conduct research that informs the equality of delivery regarding comprehensive sexuality education and contributes to our understanding of best practice and the local context.



Advocacy:

We promote the need for commitments to establish comprehensive sexuality education programs in schools and universities, and for the implementation of national sexual and reproductive health policies for all.
