- Checks and treatment for Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)
- HIV/AIDS tests and counselling
- Disability clinical services and access
- Sexual health information
- Advice and counselling for preconception, infertility, premenstrual tension, menstrual disorders, sterilisation and menopause management

provides health promotion and education services to community groups in Dubbo and surrounding areas.

Training and education of health professionals is also provided in collaboration with the Family Planning NSW Professional Education Unit.
