COMPREHENSIVE SEXUALITY EDUCATION




CERVICAL CANCER



Family Planning NSW supports the development of cervical cancer screening and treatment programs that aim to reduce the mortality from this preventable disease by training health professionals in screening processes, providing education about cervical cancer, and encouraging women to be screened for early detection and treatment.



CONTRACEPTION

Family Planning NSW supports increasing access to safe, effective and affordable methods of contraception in the Indo-Pacific by building the capacity of health systems to provide information, counselling and services so families can actively plan whether to have children, when to have them and how many to have.

OUR APPROACH



Build Partnerships:

We engage with communities and in-country organisations to design and deliver customised services and education.



Health Promotion:

We provide health system with the technical skills and information to increase access to sexual and reproductive health services.



Capacity Building:

We use a train-the-trainer approach to build local capacity of technical skills and knowledge so that programs are locally owned and sustained.



Translate evidence into practice:

We use local and international research and knowledge that aligns with best practice and the local context.



Advocacy:

We promote the need for comprehensive sexual and reproductive health and rights for all.



Gender and Disability:

Our aim is to empower women, girls and people with disability to make decisions about their own sexual and reproductive health.

We actively support the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals, with a close alignment to SDG 3 on healthy lives and SDG 5 on gender equality.
