Family Planning NSW aims to eradicate cervical cancer in the Pacific through training clinicians on modern screening and treatment methods, providing information and education to communities, and developing national guidelines on cervical cancer.

Cervical cancer is one of the most preventable and treatable cancers. Australia is set to become the first country in the world to eliminate cervical cancer. Yet, many countries in the Indo-Pacific region do not have national prevention and screening programs.

Comprehensive:



OUR APPROACH



Build Partnerships:

We work with governments and local health providers to determine the most appropriate method of cervical cancer prevention, screening and treatment.



Health Promotion:

We work with health professionals and community health workers to provide cervical cancer screening and treatment information and education.



Capacity Building:

We use a train-the-trainer approach to build and enhance the capacity of health systems and local service providers so that programs are appropriate to the local context and sustainable.



Evidence-based:

Our programs are evidence-based and undergo a rigorous evaluation process and have demonstrated effectiveness with the specific population groups they serve.



Advocacy:

We promote the need for comprehensive cervical cancer prevention, screening and treatment approaches to national governments, international donors and other stakeholders.
