Abortion: a GP's toolkit is aimed at experienced GPs and practice nurses with an interest in women's health.

Abortion: a GP's toolkit will provide a practical framework for approaching abortion-related cases, highlighting the common issues related to requests for abortion, as well as the current guidelines for management of post-abortion complications.

The topics will cover the law for abortion provision in NSW, informed consent, abortion provider options and relevant costs, the telehealth options, the use of interpreters and the situations where reproductive coercion is involved.

The session will then shift its focus on to clinical management of common complications after medical and surgical abortion, using comprehensive case studies and real-time discussion of questions with the expert panel.
