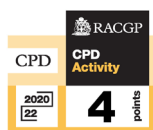

A graduate of the University of Sydney, Annabelle trained as a histopathologist at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital. She was Director of Anatomical Pathology at the Royal Hospital for Women, Paddington, before joining the Douglass practice in 1995. She is a specialist gynaecological histopathologist and cytopathologist and is the Director of Cytopathology and GynaePath and Medical Director at Douglass Hanly Moir Pathology. She is a past President of the Australian Society of Cytology and a member of the Executive Committee of the International Academy of Cytology. She is the current President of the Australian Society of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology. Annabelle is Head of Pathology at the University of Notre Dame, School of Medicine Sydney. She has published numerous papers and is co-author of a respected textbook on ovarian pathology.
