Reproductive and Sexual Health for Midwives

This course aims to increase midwives' ability to provide holistic care for women and their families during the reproductive continuum.

You will:

- Increase your understanding of STIs in the perinatal period including taking a relevant history
- Gain confidence in educating women on their postnatal contraception choices
- Broaden your skills in caring for women with a disability
- Explore trauma informed care and self-care

This course consists of a 16 week online e-Learning program providing participants with a greater understanding of reproductive and sexual health issues. The program includes a two day interactive workshop in Week 8.

Whilst the course does not contain a clinical component, it will be combined with the Cervical Screening Upskilling Module and a practice patient session for clinical practice in cervix location in the non-pregnant woman and cervical sampling simulation.

Course fee includes both *Reproductive and Sexual Health: an Australian Clinical Practice Handbook*, 3rd edition e-book and *Contraception: an Australian Clinical Practice Handbook* 4th edition e-book.
